1. Approve Minutes from Previous Meeting

A motion was made by Mike Klein and seconded by John Taylor to approve the minutes from the October 14th 2021 meeting. A voice vote was taken and the motion was approved unanimously.

2. Tax Rate Area layers schema change

STAB approved the following schema change to all of the 20 District layers provided as part of the Tax Rate Area updates with the standard 5 day notification. The Field FUND is to change from double to long, and the DISTRICT field length is to change from 255 characters to 50.

3. SanGIS Website

SanGIS redesigned the SanGIS website through ArcGIS Hub with some elements included as story map apps. Documentation is being migrated for Portal so that the existing website can be entirely replaced by the new one. The url is <https://sangis-website-test-sangis1.hub.arcgis.com/>

STAB approved the migration to the new website in the New Year with the addition of a gallery card item for SANDAG most popular web services.

4. Remove Slopes_1999_SD layer

This item was removed from the agenda and the layer is to be retained.

5. SanGIS Portal

SanGIS seeks STAB input on how SanGIS can best leverage Portal to serve the JPA and public at large. SanGIS would like to use the SanGIS Portal as a collaboration group for a purchase access point for other agencies. Jason has undertaken bulk feature publishing and is planning to make these data available. There is a collaboration setting between individual agencies available to use when needed for ad hoc projects. Scott Daeschner does not want collaboration to replace existing data sharing.

7. Announcements / Other Information

SanGIS received the American Community Survey Demography data which has been processed and metadata added. Unfortunately as there are 3000+ fields in the data layers it was not possible to add them to SDE due to SQL Server restrictions. SanGIS is to send data details to STAB for comment and review.

SANDAG have no ETA for processing the 2020 Census Data.

The State had released new Alquist Priolo Fault Zones data for Point Loma and La Jolla. The City will work on updating the City dataset. SanGIS queried if there should be a countywide dataset created. The City will contact the County about this.
