Topics:

1. Approve Minutes from Previous Meeting

A motion was made by Jessica Sanchez and seconded by Jason Bachelor to approve the minutes from the October 13th, 2022, meeting. A voice vote was taken and the motion was approved unanimously.

2. City Drainage layers schema change

STAB approved schema changes to the DRAIN_CONVEYANCE and DRAIN_STRUCTURE layers following the standard 5 days' notice. The last_edited_mdg_date and last_edited_mdg_user fields are no longer published.

3. Remove BUS_CONSTRUCTION_DEMO_RECYCLE layer

STAB approved the removal of the BUS_CONSTRUCTION_DEMO_RECYCLE layer from SanGIS SDE following the standard 5-days' notice. The layer is incorrect and is no longer maintained. It has already been removed from the RDW.

4. Remove GENERAL_PLAN_LAND_USE layer

STAB approved the removal of the GENERAL_PLAN_LAND_USE layer from SanGIS SDE following the standard 5-days' notice. This layer is a duplicate of the GENERAL_PLAN_LAND_USE_SD layer that was accidentally created at some point and is not updated. The layer is not replicated as part of the ADR process.

5. State ECO_CNDDDB Schema Change

STAB approved schema changes to the State ECO_CNDDDB layer following the standard 5-day notice. The schema change is for a field type change from Long to Short for the following fields: OCCNUMBER, ELMTYPE, EOCOUNT.

6. ECO_WETLAND schema change

STAB approved schema changes to the Federal (US Fish and Wildlife) ECO_WETLAND layer following the standard 5-day notice. The schema change requires the removal of the QAQC_CODE field and re-naming WETLAND_TY field to WETLAND_TYPE as per the updated Federal layer.

7. CHRIS Data Discussion

The CHRIS data comprises historical and cultural data in the form of GIS data and a catalog of pdf documents. The data is part of an annual subscription managed by San Diego State Hub and is highly restricted. The County and City currently have separate processes to acquire and update this data and would like for SanGIS to manage the GIS data acquisition and update process via the ADR process. The County is to review how this data would be provided to SanGIS.

8. Parcel Fabric Annotation

There are new annotation layers associated with Parcel Fabric. Existing ArcMap Annotation layers are no longer maintained and will remain static. STAB seeks input on when they can be deleted. New annotation layers with a different schema will be provided as part of the Parcel Fabric. Jennifer Benavides is to review when these layers can be removed from the County Assessors process. This topic is to be re-visited at the April STAB meeting.

9. Remove TBL_ADDRESS table

There is a static table called TBL_ADDRESS that SanGIS publishes every week. This table is replicated by ADR to both City and County. It consists of address points joined to road names. However, it is never updated in the edit environment. SanGIS are not sure if it should be updated in the edit environment or if it should be removed from our weekend process. As far as we can tell it hasn't been updated since 2015. STAB members are to review who uses this table and why, and the topic is to be re-visited at the April STAB meeting.

10. Metadata discussion

SanGIS have worked with Quartic to successfully create an Add-In for Pro (v3.0) that allows editing and publication of metadata using the RGDW stylesheet. The edit environment, however does not just have a short-list of the required metadata items (unlike the review/ publication view) as it would require significant re-development to create a tailored edit environment. Louise is to send a Pro v.3.0 add in to Deena Bowman and Adam Attar to test. Louise will also work on detailed documentation on metadata editing in the Pro environment. Louise will ask Quartic if they can compile one for Pro version 2.8/2.9 for the County.

Announcements / Other Information

STAB meetings are now back in person. SanGIS has asked for input at the next meeting if there is a preference for what day of the week the meeting should take place.

Scott Daeschner wishes to discuss Lidar for Tree Canopy data compilation at the next meeting.

Christine Shaw will be updating the Lifeguard layer with data from NorthComm.
