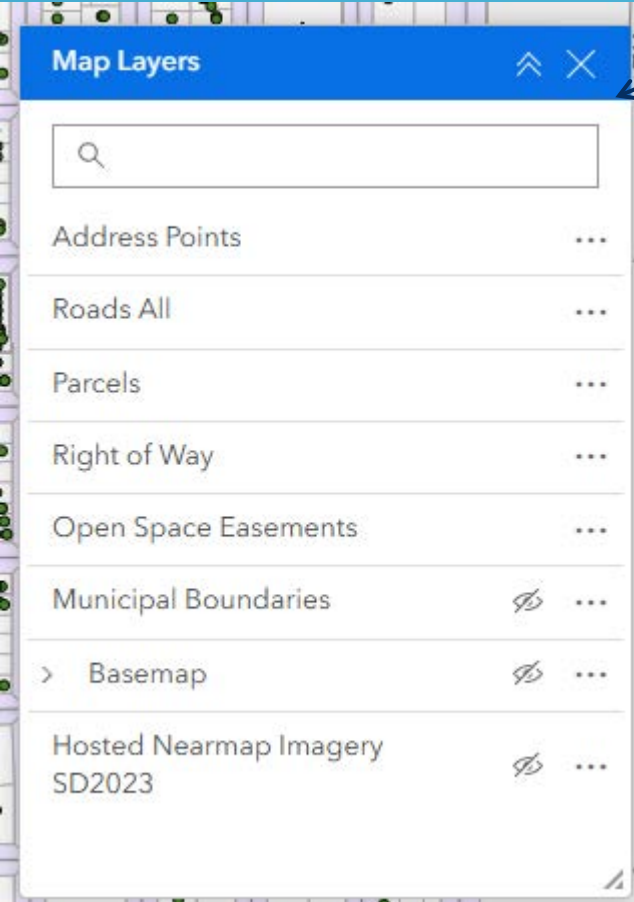

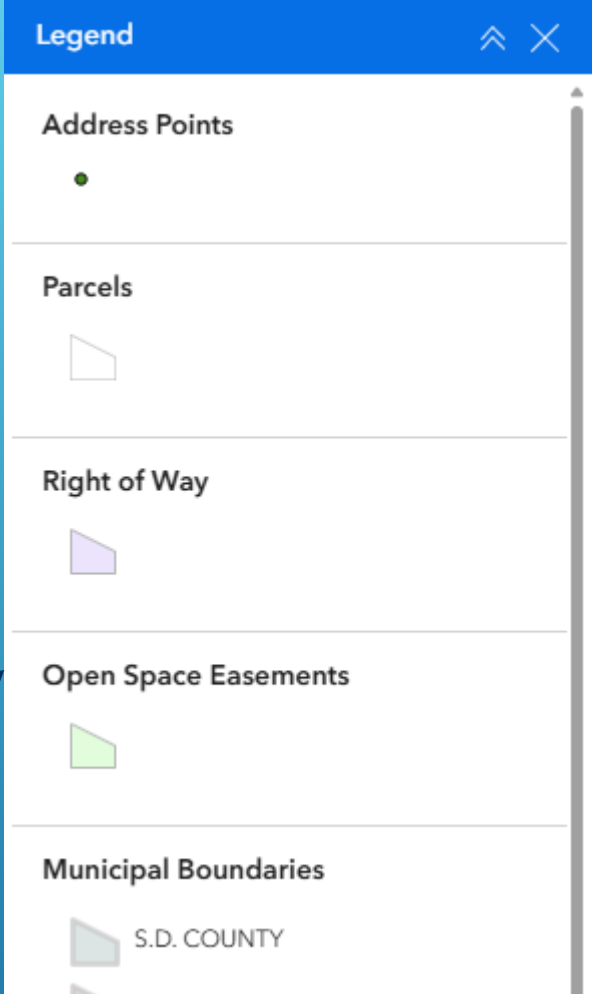

# Map Layers & Legend

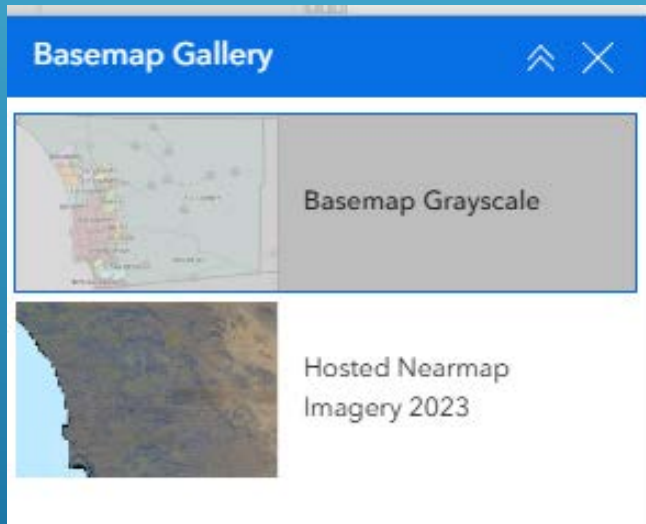
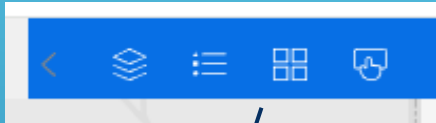


Use the eye  button to turn layers on and off. The Municipal Boundaries, Basemap and Imagery layers are turned off as the default option, while the land base layers only display at smaller scales (as you zoom in close, they will automatically appear on the map).

The Legend will only show layers that are currently displayed.

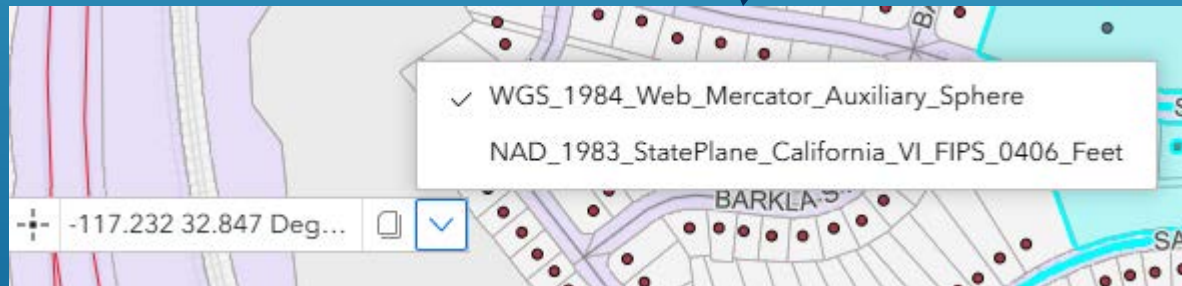


# Change Basemap / Get co-ordinates

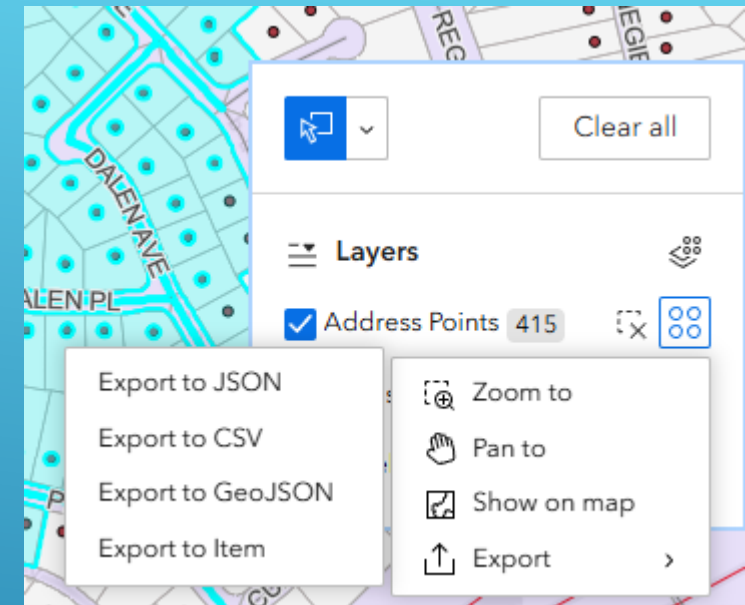
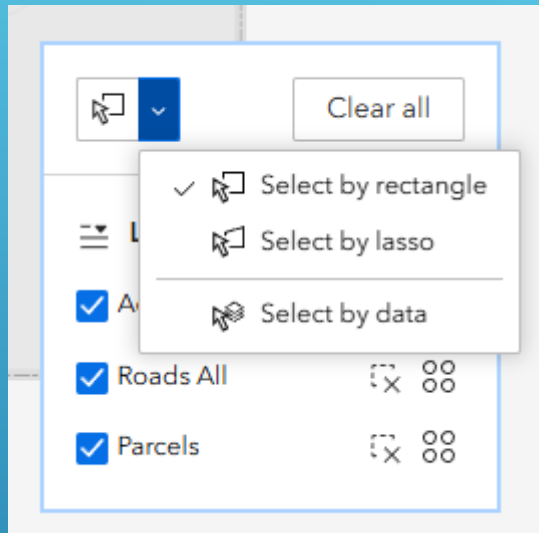


Alternative basemap to swap with the grayscale on displayed as the default. You can also turn on aerial imagery via the Layer List.


At the bottom left of the map screen you can get co-ordinates for where you point on the map screen. Use the down arrow to choose between WGS84 or NAD 83 State Plane.



# Select & Export Tool



1. Zoom or pan to your area of interest on the map.
2. Choose the desired Select option (rectangle, lasso or data)
3. Then on the map, select the area of interest.

4. Click on the Action  button to select what action you want for your selected data. You can export the Address Points, Roads All and Parcels data (minus owner attribution) to various formats.
5. Use the Clear all button to clear or reset or just refresh the entire app
